Adult Vaccinations

Stolley Park Veterinary Hospital Recommended Vaccinations

Prior to vaccination we recommend a
**Feline Virus Blood Test for Leukemia and
Feline Immunodeficiency Virus.**

- **Rabies**

Rabies is required by law.

- **There are 2 types of Rabies vaccinations available for cats**
- Three year Rabies, which is given at 3 months of age, one year later, then *every 3 years*.

OR

- Purevax Rabies, which is given at 3 months, then *every year*.
- Purevax is considered less likely to cause a vaccine-associated cancer than the three-year Rabies.
- Purevax is given if you choose a "Series".

- **Feline Distemper (PRCC)**

- Panleukopenia, Rhinotracheitis, Calicivirus, Chlamydia
- This vaccine protects against respiratory viruses that are very common in unprotected cats.
- This is given *every year*.

- **Feline Leukemia Virus**

- Feline Leukemia is a virus passed by close contact between cat to cat. This can mean fighting or grooming. It is very common in our area. If there is any chance your cat will go outside or can escape, we recommend this.
- This is given *every year*.

Parasites

Another key ingredient of core canine care is parasite control.

Monthly preventative is recommended for:

Fleas

Ticks

& Intestinal Parasites:

Hookworms

Roundworms

Also consider preventing:

Heartworms

Ear Mites

Monitoring for these include regular examinations by your veterinarian and annual fecal exams.
